THE DIRECTOR GASTROENTEROLOGIST POST WHICH I CURRENTLY HOLD IS A FULL TIME JOB OF THE GREEK NHS. "G.GENNIMATAS" ATHENS GENERAL HOSPITAL IS A BIG BUSY TERTIARY HOSPITAL, WITH 650 BEDS, SERVING A POPULATION OF TWO MILLION. . IT OFFERS PROGRAMMED ACTIVITIES AS WELL AS ACUTE GASTROENTEROLOGY SERVICE 1 IN 4 DAYS. THE GASTROENTEROLOGY CLINIC HAS 18 BEDS AND 5 SHORT STAY BEDS WITH AN AVERAGE OF 2000 HOSPITALIZATION / YEAR MAINLY BILIARY AND PANCREATIC DISEASES AND ALSO IBD, COMPLICATIONS OF CIRRHOSIS, GI BLEEDING.

THE ENDOSCOPY UNIT HAS 4 ROOMS FOR ENDOSCOPIC PROSEDURES, ONE OF THEM WITH RADIOLOGICAL EQUIPMENT AND ONE FOR ENDOSCOPIC ULTRASOUND.

THE ENDOSCOPIC ULTRASOUND UNIT WHICH I AM HEAD OF, IS REFERAL FOR ALL GREECE AND OPERATES DIAGNOSTIC LINEAR ENDOSCOPIC ULTRASOUND TOMOGRAPHYS OF UPPER AND LOWER G.I TRACT AND THE UPPER CELIAC ORGANS AND MEDIASTINUM (I PERSONALLY PERFORM OVER 800 INCIDENTS ANNUALLY – A TOTAL OF 18000 IN 20 YEARS) AND ULTRASOUND GUIDED FINE NEEDLE ASPIRATION (FNA) AND BIOPSY (FNB) C DIAGNOSIS ( MORE THAN 450 ANNUALLY- A TOTAL OF 10000 IN 20 YEARS), ON THE FORMER AREAS OF THE BODY, AND INTERVENTIONAL PROSEDURES SUCH AS CELIAC PLEXUS NEUROLYSIS (MORE THAN 150) AND STENTS PLACEMENT ON PSEUDOCYSTS OR WON UNDER EUS GUIDANCE (MORE THAN 100), INCLUNDING HOT AXIOS (48 UP TO NOW) AND NECROSEKTOMIES (18 UP TO NOW)
